

SECTION 2.12**FLIGHT CREW CERTIFICATE****THEORY INSTRUCTOR****PURPOSE**

1. The Operations Manager may appoint theory instructors for the purpose of providing ground instruction to all RA-Aus pilots including student pilots.

METHOD OF APPROVAL

2. A person seeking appointment to act as an RA-Aus Theory Instructor shall:
 - (a) have passed any CASA recognised private pilot licence examination/s, or
 - (b) have passed examinations considered by the Operations Manager or approved delegate to be at least equivalent to Australian private pilot licence examinations; or
 - (c) have passed examinations set by the Operations Manager or approved delegate that is deemed an RA-Aus equivalent of the CASA private pilot licence theory examination. or
 - (d) have qualifications, in the opinion of the Operations Manager or approved delegate, equivalent to or higher than the qualifications specified in Sub-Paragraph 2 a; and
 - (e) submit written justification for appointment to the Operations Manager or approved delegate; and
 - (f) pass written or verbal examinations as directed by the Operations Manager or approved delegate.

APPOINTMENT

3. Theory Instructors will be appointed, in writing, by the Operations Manager or approved delegate. The letter of appointment will specify the subject or subjects the Theory Instructor is authorised to teach.

PERIOD OF VALIDITY

4. The Operations Manager may vary, suspend or cancel the appointment of a Theory Instructor under the conditions of Section 2.14 of this Manual or upon review by the Operations Manager.
